# Day of Event Details and FAQs

#### 1. Where do I check in for the Home Tour on October 26?

To obtain entry, all Home Tour guests will need to check in at the cul-de-sac between 1 Cherry and 20 Cherry, San Francisco, CA 94118. Please look for our check-in table with event signage. Attendees will receive a wristband and a Home Tour brochure.

## 2. I am a Patron Package ticket holder – where do I check in?

All Home Tour guests will need to check in at the cul-de-sac between 1 Cherry and 20 Cherry, San Francisco, CA 94118. Please look for our check-in table with event signage. Attendees will receive a wristband and a Home Tour brochure.

#### 3. Where is the VIP Experience Lounge?

The VIP Experience area, exclusive to Patrons and Sponsors, is located in the back garden of the Tour home located at 3600 Washington Street. Patron Package ticket holders and Sponsors will need to check in prior to arriving at the VIP Experience (see above).

#### 4. What time does the Home Tour start and end?

General Admission ticket holders may view the homes from 11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on October 26. Patron Package ticket holders may view the homes from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on October 26. The last entry into homes will be at 3:45 p.m.

#### 5. Can I still buy tickets?

Yes, tickets may be purchased <u>online</u> until noon on October 25. You may also purchase Home Tour tickets on the day of the event at our check-in table located at the cul-de-sac between 1 Cherry and 20 Cherry, San Francisco, CA 94118. General Admission ticket holders have the option to become Patrons and upgrade their tickets to VIP Experience at the check-in table.

#### 6. What does the VIP Experience include?

The VIP Experience, exclusive to Patrons and Sponsors, allows access to the Tour homes one hour prior (10:00 a.m.) to General Admission ticket holders. Patrons also have exclusive access to the VIP Experience, where they may enjoy food and drinks inside a designated hospitality area. They will also receive a curated gift bag.

## 7. Will I receive my ticket in the mail?

No. Your name will be on our guest list at check-in.

# 8. How close together are the Tour homes and how many are there?

There are five homes, all located in the Presidio Heights neighborhood, some of which are within walking distance of one another. We recommend that guests wear comfortable shoes, and high-heeled shoes are **NOT** permitted in any of the homes. Shuttle service will be provided to Patron Package ticket holders, with stops located near the homes.

## 9. Where should I park for the event?

We strongly recommend attendees use public transportation or taxi/Uber/Lyft to get to the Tour. For more information on public transportation, please visit <u>511.org</u>. If you wish to drive, there is limited street parking within the Tour area.

## 10. When will I receive a map of the homes?

A map will be included in the Home Tour brochure, which will be given to you at check-in on the day of the event.

#### Please note:

- Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. High-heeled shoes are NOT
  permitted in any of the homes. You will be asked to wear the provided shoe
  covers or remove your shoes at the door of each home.
- Except for "babes in arms," children under 14 are not permitted to tour the homes. No strollers are allowed in the homes.
- No photography is allowed inside the homes.
- Shuttles will be available between homes for Patron Package ticket holders. Some homes are within comfortable walking distance.
- Bags and purses may be checked at some of the homes, per the request of the homeowners.
- Food and beverages may not be consumed within the homes, with the exception of the hospitality area reserved for Patrons and Sponsors.
